This is a dual- enrollment partnership with SUNY Erie for the Information Technology Department/Degree Program. A cohort of 48 students selected by an admission process. Students in this program receive Extended Learning Time – 90 hours per year (including Academic Support, industry related Mentoring, and Project Based Learning) and dual- credit college courses starting in 10th grade (at no cost to students).
