\*Board of Education Policy adopted June 26. 2013 regarding Career and Technical Education (CTE): Applications will be made through the Parental Choice applications for all Career and Technical Education programs for students entering 9<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> grade in accordance with the application process. Acceptance into the Career and Technical Education programs will be based on a holistic approach with the primary indicator being the student's interest. An interest inventory will be required and available through O\*NET OnLine (www.onetoline.org). The student's 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade attendance, grades, and behavior will also be evaluated holistically, but may not be used to preclude the student's admission into a Career and Technical Education program. Additionally, all available seats in 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades will be filled to capacity and no student should be denied access due to secondary indictors if an opening exists.

\*\*Poifferentiated programs are available to special education students in special classes.
